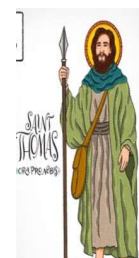

ADVENT SEASON: The second Sunday of Advent serves as a reminder to ready ourselves for the arrival of Christ. It is essential to seize the moment while we can, as the “mystery of faith” echoed during Mass should resonate within us this week: we proclaim Christ’s death and resurrection until His return. His coming will find us in one of two states: prepared or unprepared. The wise will turn away from sin, seek confession, and embark on a journey toward holiness, while the foolish may procrastinate, believing they have ample time, only to be caught off guard when the Day of the Lord arrives unexpectedly. To truly prepare for Christ’s coming, invite the Holy Spirit into your heart each day, allowing Him to guide your thoughts, actions, and words. Regularly embrace humility by prioritizing the well-being of others over your own. Strive to be a source of consolation, avoiding actions that may lead others into sin, and encourage them to remain steadfast in their faith. Live each day with the awareness that today could be your last, fostering a sense of urgency in your spiritual preparation.
