THE NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN

MARY (September 08th): Why does the Catholic church celebrate the birth of Mary? Saint Augustine described the birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary as an event of cosmic and historic significance, and an appropriate prelude to the birth of Jesus Christ. According to him, "She is the flower of the field from whom bloomed the precious lily of the valley, (Jesus Christ our Lord)". A closer examination of the life of our Blessed Mother highlights the honour and dignity that God has bestowed upon women by choosing her to bear His Son. This divine choice signifies that women need not vie with men for superiority or equality; rather, they are inherently equal due to our shared humanity. However, women enjoy a unique status of honour through Mary's intimate relationship with Christ. On Monday we not only commemorate the birth of the Mother of our Savior but also honour all women who see her as a beacon of faith, motherhood, and feminine strength. Additionally, we recognize the men who honour women as sisters, mothers, and wives. May the Blessed Virgin Mary intercede for our world and obtain for us renewal and salvation through Christ our Lord. Amen.
